### GERANIUM 'Ann Folkard'

From a clump of foliage this sends out long stems ending in magenta flowers with a black eye. It is a cross between *G. procurrens* and *G. psilostemon*.

Lilac flowers for most of the summer. Sun and dry conditions.		
<b>GERANIUM cinereum 'Jolly Jewel Night'</b>	9"	£7.60
Purple flowers with a black centre. Makes a compact clump and flowers all summer. Sun and good drainage.		
<b>GERANIUM cinereum 'Jolly Jewel Raspberry'</b>	9"	£7.60
Raspberry-red flowers. Grey-green foliage makes a carpet clump and flowers all summer. Sun and good drainage.		
<b>GERANIUM cinereum 'Jolly Jewel Salmon'</b>	9"	£7.60
Small grey-green leaves and orange salmon flowers. Un and good drainage. Another Marco Van Voort introduction.		
<b>GERANIUM cinereum 'Jolly Jewel Silver'</b>	6"	£7.60
Long flowering with large bright pink flowers, good drainage and sun.		
<b>GERANIUM cinereum 'Rothbury Gem'</b>	6"	£7.50
Grey-green foliage in a low clump, pale pink flowers with deeper veining, dry and sun.		
<b>GERANIUM clarkei 'Kashmir Pink'</b>	16"	£7.50
Finely cut leaves and bowl-shaped flowers of a beautiful soft pink. Not as vigorous as G. 'Kashmir Purple'.		
<b>GERANIUM clarkei 'Kashmir Purple'</b>	18"	£7.50
Very daintily cut leaves, purple flowers in summer. Runs gently.		
<b>GERANIUM clarkei 'Kashmir White'</b>	2'	£7.50
Warm white veined with purple giving a greyish effect. Early summer.		
<b>GERANIUM 'Coombland White'</b>		£7.80
(G. lambertii Swansdown x G. traversii) A lovely cross with trailing 2' stems and white flowers tinged with pink.		
<b>GERANIUM 'Dilys'</b>	<b>AGM</b> 9"	£7.50
One of the best Alan Bremner hybrids, masses of pink flowers from June until the frosts. G.sanguineum x G.procurrens		

<b>GERANIUM ‘Dragon Heart’</b> New hybrid with very large magenta flowers throughout the summer. Best trailing through other plants. Bred by Alan Bremner. <b>PBR</b>	2"	£7.80
<b>GERANIUM ‘Elke’</b> Lots of large deep pink flowers, the petals edged with white.	9"	£7.60
<b>GERANIUM ‘Eureka Blue’</b> Large blue flowers in summer. Green foliage turns reddish in autumn. Sport of ‘Orion’ from Brian Krabbes.	18"	£7.50
<b>GERANIUM endressii ‘Wargrave Pink’</b> Salmon-pink small flowers in June. Light green leaves.	2'	£7.50
<b>GERANIUM ‘Hexham Velvet’</b> Marbled foliage, pink flowers in late summer. Sprawling.	2'	£7.70
<b>GERANIUM himalayense ‘Derrick Cook’</b> Large white flowers with darker veining.	1'	£7.50
<b>GERANIUM himalayense ‘Gravetye’</b> This form has larger blue flowers and is more compact.	<b>AGM</b> 1'	£7.50
<b>GERANIUM himalayense ‘Irish Blue’</b> Large cup shaped flowers of pale blue throughout the summer. Spreading.	1'	£7.50

<b>GERANIUM ‘Joy’</b> Beautiful pale pink, bowl shaped flowers in late summer. Makes a mound of foliage topped with masses of flowers.	14"	£7.70
<b>GERANIUM ‘JS Ma Tu Vu’</b> A low growing form of G. psilostemon. Magenta flowers with a black eye. <b>PBR</b>	1'	£7.80
<b>GERANIUM kishtvariense</b> Large bright pinkish-purple flowers in late summer. Best in some shade and not too dry conditions.	1'	£7.50
<b>GERANIUM libani</b> The foliage of this species disappears in the summer and appears the following autumn. Violet-blue flowers.	1'6"	£7.60

<b>GERANIUM macrorrhizum ‘Czakar’</b> Deep carmine flowers over the usual fragrant evergreen foliage		16”	£7.50
<b>GERANIUM macrorrhizum ‘Ingwersen’s Variety’</b> Excellent evergreen groundcover, green fragrant foliage, soft pink flowers.	<b>AGM</b>	1’	£7.50

<b>GERANIUM maculatum ‘Espresso’</b> Dark brown foliage and bright pink flowers in summer.		1’6”	£7.50
<b>GERANIUM x magnificum</b> Hairy leaves which turn red in autumn. Blue flowers.	<b>AGM</b>	2’	£7.60
<b>GERANIUM malviflorum</b> Becoming dormant after flowering in May this has violet-blue flowers with darker veining on the petals.		18”	£7.50
<b>GERANIUM ‘Mavis Simpson’</b> From a small clump of grey foliage this sends out trailing stems covered with clear pink flowers throughout the summer.	<b>AGM</b>	9”	£7.50
<b>GERANIUM ‘Nimbus’</b> Deep violet-purple starry flowers, very feathery foliage which is golden green in spring.	<b>AGM</b>	18”	£7.50

Pure white flowers all summer. Will grow in dry shade.			
<b>GERANIUM nodosum 'Svelte Lilac'</b>		18"	£7.50
Excellent for dry shade. Pretty lilac flowers most of the summer.			
<b>GERANIUM nodosum 'Tony's Talisman'</b>	<b>NEW</b>	18"	£7.90
A long flowering form with purple flowers, good in shade.			
<b>GERANIUM 'Orion'</b>	<b>AGM</b>	18"	£7.60
Large, bright blue flowers with darker veining.			
<b>GERANIUM x oxonianum 'A.T.Johnson'</b>	<b>AGM</b>	18"	£7.50
Pinky-mauve flowers for most of the summer. If cut down after flowering will often flower again.			
<b>GERANIUM x oxonianum 'Kate Moss'</b>		18"	£7.50
G. endressii x versicolor. Very pale pink on spreading plants. This, and 'Rebecca Moss' were given to me by Robin Moss who has named them after his children.			
<b>GERANIUM x oxonianum 'Rebecca Moss'</b>		18"	£7.50
G. endressii x versicolor. Not quite as pale pink as 'Kate Moss'.			
<b>GERANIUM x oxonianum 'Sherwood'</b>		2'6"	£7.50
Narrow pale pink petals. Flowers throughout the summer and I have never had a seedling problem!			
<b>GERANIUM x oxonianum 'Spring Fling'</b>		18"	£7.50
The golden leaves are marked with dark blotches. Pale pink flowers.

Sprawling clumps covered with bright pink flowers most of the summer. Easy			
<b>GERANIUM 'Patricia'</b>	<b>AGM</b>	2'6"	£7.80
(G. endressii x G. psilostemon) Bright pink with a darker eye, flowering for months making this an excellent form.			
<b>GERANIUM phaeum 'Album'</b>		2'	£7.50
Reflexed white flowers. Good in shade.			
<b>GERANIUM phaeum 'Alec's Pink'</b>		2'	£7.50
Pinkish lilac flowers in early summer. Another good shade plant.			

<b>GERANIUM phaeum ‘Joan Baker’</b>	2’6”	£7.50
Quite large flowers on tall plants. The flowers are bluish-purple. Good in shade.		
<b>GERANIUM phaeum ‘Joseph Green’</b> <b>NEW</b>	18”	£7.90
Dusky purple double flowers with a centre of small green petals.		
<b>GERANIUM phaeum ex ‘Lily Lovell’</b>	18”	£7.50
The original was given to me by Trevor Bath who had named it after his mother. The flowers are dark, almost black and relatively large. Excellent in the shade.		
<b>GERANIUM phaeum ‘Margaret Wilson’</b>	1’	£7.90
One of the best new variegated plants, creamy yellow veining on foliage. Purplish flowers in early summer. Will do well in shade.		
<b>GERANIUM phaeum ‘Stillingfleet Ghost’</b>	2’	£7.90
One of our seedlings which was on trial with David Hibberd and named by him. Pale grey flowers of a reasonable size, a useful colour to add to the range of G. phaeum so good in shade.		
<b>GERANIUM phaeum var.phaeum ‘Samobor’</b>	2’	£7.50
Grown for its wonderful leaves. Large dark-brown blotches in the centre of each leaf. Very good in shade.		
<b>GERANIUM phaeum ‘Wendy’s Blush’</b> <b>NEW</b>	18”	£7.90
Very pale pink flowers with a deeper centre. Much admired this summer in the garden.		
<b>GERANIUM ‘Phillipe Vapelle’</b>	18"	£7.50
(G. renardii x G. polypetalum) Mounds of hairy grey leaves topped by purple flowers heavily veined.		
<b>GERANIUM ‘Pink Penny’</b>	1’	£7.80
Large, deep red flowers with darker veining. A good new form.		
<b>GERANIUM pratense ‘Cloud Nine’</b>	2’	£7.80
Double pale blue ruffled flowers in mid-summer. <b>PBR</b>		
<b>GERANIUM pratense ‘Else Lacey’</b>	2’	£7.60
Loose double blue flowers with green centres from Wendy Perry’s Garden in Truro.		
<b>GERANIUM pratense ‘Laura’</b>	1’	£7.60
A new pure white double flowered geranium from Christine Morley. Sterile so flowers for most of the Summer. <b>PBR</b>

Red stems, rose-pink flushed foliage and soft pink flowers in summer. Beautiful and easy.

<b>GERANIUM pyrenaicum</b> A rare native with attractive rounded leaves and mauve-pink flowers for months. Can be short lived but usually self-seeds.		1’	£7.10
<b>GERANIUM ‘Red Admiral’</b> Delighted to have this Geranium from Robin Moss. Dark purple- red flowers with a small dark centre and dark veins. G.psilostemon x G.sylvaticum.		1’6”	£7.50
<b>GERANIUM renardii</b> Sage green circular leaves. White flowers veined with mauve in early summer.	<b>AGM</b>	1’	£7.50

<b>GERANIUM ‘Rozanne’</b> Large blue flowers with a white eye. Needs sun and best sprawling through other plants. Flowers mid-summer until the frosts. <b>PBR</b>	<b>AGM</b>	18”	£7.70
<b>GERANIUM ‘Sabani Blue’</b> Masses of good green foliage, large deep blue flowers in early summer. Another good plant from Alan Bremner <b>PBR</b> .		16”	£7.50

<b>GERANIUM 'Stephanie'</b> (G. peloponnesiacum x G. renardii) Large, pale blue flowers in spring. Good textured leaves make tight clumps		1'	£7.50
<b>GERANIUM 'Storm Chaser'</b> Lilac pink flowers with a dark magenta eye. Late summer.		1'	£7.80
<b>GERANIUM 'Summer Skies'</b> I cannot imagine why this is called 'Summer Skies' as the double flowers are pinky-blue rather than sky blue. But very attractive anyway. <b>PBR</b>		18"	£7.60

<b>GERANIUM wallichianum 'Crystal Lake'</b> Large silvery blue flowers, veined with purple. Lovely growing through other plants. A beautiful new addition, flowering in late summer. <b>PBR</b>	18"	£7.80
<b>GERANIUM wallichianum 'Havana Blues'</b> Large blue flowers with dark veins. Flowers from June to the frost.	15"	£7.80
<b>GERANIUM wallichianum 'Kelly Anne'</b> Bright pink flowers with darker veining. Flowers in late summer. Sprawling.	<b>NEW</b> 18"	£7.80
<b>GERANIUM wallichianum 'Rise and Shine'</b> Blue purple flowers with a white eye and pink veins. Late Summer. Marco van Noort introduction.	1'	£7.80
<b>GERANIUM wallichianum 'Sweet Heidi'</b> Blue-purple petals surround a white eye edged with pink. Flowers all summer. Sprawling. <b>PBR</b>	14"	£7.80
<b>GERANIUM wlassovianum</b> Purple flowers in late summer and foliage which turns red at the approach of autumn.	18"	£7.50
<b>GERANIUM yeoi</b> A biennial, rather like G. palmatum. Large overwintering rosettes, red stems and deep pink flowers. Syn. G. rubescens	16"	£7.20
<b>GERANIUM yesoense</b> Deeply cut leaves, saucer shaped pink flowers veined with darker pink. Bushy. Needs not too dry conditions.	1'	£7.50
