<b>ACHILLEA 'Credo'</b> Creamy yellow flowers. Tallish.	AGM	3'	£7.00
<b>ACHILLEA 'Lachsschoenheit'</b> Soft peach flowers in mid-summer inspire the name 'Salmon Beauty'. If cut back flowers again in autumn.	AGM	2'	£7.00
<b>ACHILLEA millefolium 'Red Velvet'</b> Rich red flowers which hold their colour throughout the summer. Needs Sun.	AGM	2'	£7.00

<b>ACTAEA matsumurae 'White Pearl'</b> Green divided foliage. Bottle brushes of white flowers in autumn. Needs some shade and good soil.	AGM	4'	£7.90
<b>ACTAEA pachypoda 'Misty Blue'</b> Blue-green foliage, stems topped with white flowers in late spring and white berries on red stalks in the autumn.	NEW	2'	£7.90

<b>ACTAEA racemosa</b>	<b>AGM</b>	4'	£7.90
Pure white flowers form the 'bottle brushes' on this excellent plant. Flowers appear from late summer through to autumn.			
<b>ACTAEA simplex 'Atropurpurea Group'</b>		4'	£7.90
Brown stems and foliage. Spires of white scented flowers in early autumn. Only a few available.			
<b>ACTAEA simplex 'Brunette'</b>	<b>AGM</b>	4'	£8.20
Dark purple foliage with pinky-white flowers in late summer. Fragrant.			
<b>ADENOPHORA pereskiifolia 'White Blaze'</b>		3'	£7.50
Spikes of white bells tinged with blue for most of the summer			
<b>ADENOPHORA potaninii</b>	<b>NEW</b>	3'	£7.40
Elegant stems studded with small pale blue flowers. Spreads.			
<b>AEGOPODIUM podogaria 'Variegatum'</b>		1'	£6.60
The variegated ground elder, not as vigorous as the plain variety.			
<b>AEONIUM balsamiferum</b>		2'	£7.50
I am delighted we now know its name so can offer this succulent with saucer-shaped rosettes smelling of honey. Not hardy here.			
<b>AGAPANTHUS 'Black Buddhist'</b>		2'	£8.90
Dark stems and violet flowers. Deciduous, so hardier than most.			
<b>AGAPANTHUS 'Black Magic'</b>		2'	£8.90
Almost black buds from which inky pendant flowers open in summer. Needs winter protection.			
<b>AGAPANTHUS 'Fireworks'</b>	<b>AGM</b>	2'	£8.90
Huge heads of white flowers flushed with a dark blue at the base. Protect from frost. <b>PBR</b>			
<b>AGAPANTHUS 'Golden Drop'</b>		16"	£8.90
Leaves edged with golden yellow. Pale blue flowers. Sun, hardy, dwarf. <b>PBR</b>			
<b>AGAPANTHUS 'Icicles'</b>		3'	£8.90
A white deciduous form so much hardier in the North.			
<b>AGAPANTHUS 'Megan's Mauve'</b>	<b>AGM</b>	2'6"	£8.90
Evergreen foliage, large bluey-mauve flowers with a central stripe of dark blue on each petal.			

<b>AGAPANTHUS ‘Midnight Star’</b> Very dark blue flowers. Deciduous, so hardier than most.	<b>AGM</b>	2’	£8.90
<b>AGAPANTHUS ‘Northern Star’</b> Dark purple buds, star-shaped blue flowers with a darker Stripe. Deciduous. <b>PBR</b>	<b>AGM</b>	2’	£9.20

<b>AGERATINA altissima ‘Chocolate’</b> Very dark brown foliage, white flowers in late summer. The foliage colours best in sun.		2’	£7.80
<b>AJUGA reptans ‘Black Scallop’</b> Very dark glossy leaves making excellent ground cover in sun. Fat spikes of deep blue flowers. <b>PBR</b>		6”	£6.60
<b>ALCHEMILLA erythropoda</b> Like a miniature A. mollis.	<b>AGM</b>	6”	£6.50
<b>ALCHEMILLA mollis</b> Lady’s mantle. Mound of rounded foliage, lime green flowers.	<b>AGM</b>	18”	£6.50
<b>ALLIUM ‘Lavender Bubbles’</b> Spreading clumps of blue-green foliage, dusky purple spherical head in late summer. Good bee plant.		1’	£7.50

Perennial form of allium making good clumps with pinky-purple spherical flower heads in summer. Dry conditions.			
<b>ALSTROEMERIA 'Indian Summer'</b>		2'	£9.80
Bronze foliage and exotic orange and yellow flowers from early summer onward. Well drained conditions. <b>PBR</b>			
<b>ALSTROEMERIA 'Mauve Majesty'</b>		2'	£7.80
Purple to mauve flowers in late summer. Hardy here.			
<b>ALSTROEMERIA 'Sweet Laura'</b>		18"	£7.80
Yellow and apricot flowers, vigorous and hardy. Late summer into autumn. <b>PBR</b>			
<b>AMSONIA tabernaemontana</b>		2'	£7.50
Loose sprays of starry slate blue flowers in early summer. Sun. Excellent autumn colour.			
<b>ANAPHALIS nepalensis var.monocephala</b>		1'	£7.50
Greyish foliage covered with white 'everlasting' flowers from July. Forms a good mound.			
<b>ANEMONE 'Dreaming Swan'</b>	<b>NEW</b>	2'	£8.00
Soft pink flowers fading to white, with a purple reverse. Flowers in autumn. Needs fertile soil.			
<b>ANEMONE hupehensis 'Praecox'</b>		3'	£7.30
One of the earliest to flower in August. Single rosy pink.			
<b>ANEMONE hupehensis 'Rotkappchen'</b>		2'	£7.30
Semi-double dusky red flowers in autumn.			
<b>ANEMONE hupehensis var. japonica 'Pamina'</b>	<b>AGM</b>	2'6"	£7.30
A low growing form with up-turned flowers of deep pink. Compact.			
<b>ANEMONE x hybrid 'Andrea Atkinson'</b>		3'	£7.30
Large single white flowers in autumn. Good in shade			
<b>ANEMONE x hybrida 'Queen Charlotte'</b>		3'	£7.30
Large semi-double soft pink flowers in autumn.			
<b>ANEMONE x hybrida 'Whirlwind'</b>		3'	£7.30
Semi-double white flowered form.			
<b>ANEMONE leveillei</b>		18"	£7.50
Single white flowers, flushed with pink and with lots of dark anthers. Flowering in June.			
<b>ANEMONE multifida (magellanica)</b>		1'	£7.50
Creamy white flowers followed by woolly seed heads.			

<b>ANEMONE nemorosa 'Viridiflora'</b>		6"	£6.30
Wood anemone where instead of petals there are fern-like leaves making a pretty rosette.			
<b>ANEMONE ranunculoides</b>	<b>AGM</b>	18"	£6.30
Yellow flowers in spring on this running wood anemone.			
<b>ANEMONE sylvestris</b>		1'	£7.40
The snowdrop anemone has small nodding white flowers in early summer followed by fluffy seed heads.			
<b>ANGELICA archangelica</b>		6'	£7.00
Tall, statuesque biennial.			
<b>ANTHEMIS tinctoria 'Sauce Hollandaise'</b>		2'6"	£7.50
The same dark green foliage as 'E C Buxton' but the pale-yellow flowers fade to white. Best in sun and well drained conditions.			
<b>ANTHRISCUS sylvestris 'Golden Fleece'</b>		2'	£7.20
Cow parsley with brilliant lemon- yellow foliage fading during summer to green. White flowers in early summer.			
<b>ANTHRISCUS sylvestris 'Ravenswing'</b>		2'6"	£7.20
A cow parsley with brown leaves. The usual white flowers. Biennial.			
<b>ARISARUM proboscideum</b>		6"	£7.20
The small brown flowers look like little mice. They appear in May and the foliage disappears in late summer.			
<b>ARMORACIA rusticana 'Variegata'</b>		3'	£7.60
Variegated Horseradish. In the Spring the large upright leaves are splashed with white. Small white flowers in early summer.			
<b>ARTEMISIA abrotanum</b>	<b>NEW</b>	3'	£760
Strongly scented grey foliage. Prune in spring. Large plants			
<b>ARTEMISIA lactiflora Guizhou Group</b>		4'	£7.60
This form has brown stems and greeny-black leaves with the usual creamy flowers in late summer.			
<b>ARTEMISIA ludoviciana 'Silver Queen'</b>		2'6"	£7.50
Upright growth, broad grey leaves. Dies down in winter.			
<b>ARTEMISIA pontica</b>		2'	£7.20
Very finely cut grey foliage with insignificant flowers. Spreads quite rapidly and good under shrub roses.			
<b>ARTEMISIA 'Powis Castle'</b>	<b>AGM</b>	2'6"	£7.50
Non-flowering hardy evergreen shrub, pale grey foliage.			

<b>ARTEMISIA vulgaris ‘Oriental Limelight’</b> In the spring has interesting green foliage splashed with yellow. Will fade during the summer. Spreading.		3’6”	£7.30
<b>ARUM italicum ‘Pictum’</b> The marbled leaves appear in the autumn and survive the worst winter weather. Lords and ladies flowers are followed by spikes of red berries when the leaves have disappeared.	<b>AGM</b>	18”	£7.00
<b>ARUNCUS dioicus</b> A large plant with handsome leaves and large cream plumes in mid-summer. Will survive anywhere.	<b>AGM</b>	5’	£7.90
<b>ARUNCUS ‘Horatio’</b> Airy Astilbe-like creamy-white flowers. Finely cut foliage with good autumn colour. An Ernst Pagel’s introduction.		2’6”	£7.90
<b>ASARUM epigynum ‘Takasago-Saishin’</b> Arrow-shaped dark green foliage veined with silver. Evergreen and will grow in dark shade.	<b>AGM</b>	6”	£7.50
<b>ASARUM europaeum</b> Grown for its shiny, round, evergreen leaves. Insignificant flowers. Good ground cover.	<b>AGM</b>	9”	£7.50
<b>ASARUM splendens</b> Large evergreen leaves marked with silver very like an evergreen hardy cyclamen. Insignificant flowers in spring.		6”	£7.50
<b>ASTER ageratoides ‘Ashri’</b> Clump forming and covered with white flowers from July until the frosts.		2’6”	£7.50
<b>ASTER ageratoides ‘Harry Smith’</b> Dark stems topped with many pink flowers in autumn. Good even in dry shade.		2’	£7.50
<b>ASTER aurelius ‘Brilliant’</b> Bushy, covered with shaggy pink flowers in late summer. Ideal to pick.		2’6”	£7.50
<b>ASTER lanceolatus ‘Edwin Beckett’</b> Large clusters of pale pink flowers edged with violet. Very pretty and excellent to cut. Autumn bee plant.		5’	£7.50

<b>ASTILBE ‘Chocolate Shogun’</b>		2'	£7.80
Brown coloured glossy foliage, pale pink flowers in mid-summer.			
<b>ASTRANTIA major ‘Buckland’</b>		2'	£7.50
One of the best Astrantias. Large dusty-pink flowers surrounded by silver- green bracts.			
<b>ASTRANTIA major ‘Roma’</b>	<b>AGM</b>	2'	£7.50
Large silver- pink flowers over a long period. <b>PBR</b>			

<b>ASTRANTIA major ‘Ruby Giant’</b>		2’6”	£7.50
Large deep pink flowers in summer. Best in sun. Good bee plant.			
<b>ASTRANTIA major ‘Star of Beauty’</b>		2’	£7.70
Two-tone effect with clusters of tiny white and purplish red flowers. <b>PBR</b>			
<b>ASTRANTIA major ‘Sunningdale Variegated’</b>	<b>AGM</b>	2’ 6	£7.60
Greenish-white flowers, the leaves are splashed with yellow. Best in sun.			
<b>ASTRANTIA major ‘Venice’</b>		2’	£7.60
Deep plum-coloured flowers on a bushy plant. Needs sun for best flower colour.			
<b>ASTRANTIA major subsp. involucrata ‘Shaggy’</b>	<b>NEW</b>	18”	£7.60
White flowers, the petals tipped with green. Mid-summer.			
<b>ASTRANTIA maxima</b>	<b>AGM</b>	2’	£7.70
Exquisite flowers, pink with pronounced ruff of rose-pink. Spreads well in good soil
