CAMPANULA 'Paul Furse' see Symphandra		
CAMPANULA punctata	1'	£7.50
Tubular bells of white, pink or maroon spotted flowers needs sun and can be invasive. Grown from seed.		
CAMPANULA 'Sarastro'	14"	£7.60
Long bells of dark purply blue, like C. 'Kent Belle' but has more flowers and is more compact.		
CAMPANULA trachelium 'Bernice'	2'	£7.50
Very double blue bells on branching stems.		
CENTAUREA dealbata 'Steenbergii'	2'	£7.50
Finely cut leaves with grey undersides. Large dark carmine flowers in summer. Useful and easy plant.		
CENTAUREA hypoleuca 'John Coutts'	2'	£7.50
Grey-green leaves and deep rose 'knapweed' flowers most of the summer.		
CENTAUREA 'Jordy'	2'	£7.50
Deep maroon flowers, unusual grey-green foliage.		
CENTAUREA montana 'Alba'	2'	£7.50
Rosettes of leaves and large white cornflowers in early summer. Best in some sun.		
CENTAUREA montana 'Black Sprite'	1'	£7.50
Purplish-black spindly flowers above a compact clump of foliage. Best in sun.		
CENTAUREA montana 'Carea'	18"	£7.50
A mound of soft green leaves and pretty pink flowers in mid-summer.		
CENTAUREA montana 'Parham'	2'	£7.50
Large pinky-mauve flowers, silver foliage.		
CENTAUREA 'Silver Feather'	18"	£7.60
Lacy silver foliage and large lilac flowers in late summer. Well drained conditions.		
CEPHALARIA gigantea	5'	£7.80
We have often been asked for this large creamy-yellow scabious. Flowers in midsummer.		

CERATOSTIGMA plumbaginoides Bright blue flowers in autumn with foliage that turns red makes this a pleasing late perennial. Needs sun and well drained conditions.	AGM	1'	£7.80
CHAEROPHYLLUM hirsutum 'Roseum' Lilac pink cow parsley-type flowers in late spring		3'	£7.50
CHAMERION angustifolia alba (syn. EPILOBIUM angustifolium var. album). The white form of rosebay willow-herb. Spires of white flowers on this plant with running roots.		5'	£7.70
CHAMERION angustifolia 'Stahl Rose' Lovely, large pink flowers with a darker eye on this willow- herb. Not too spreading and very pretty in late summer to autumn.		2'6"	£7.50
CHELONE oblique Lilac-pink flowers in early autumn are very welcome. The name 'Turtlehead' is supposed to describe the flowers.		3'	£7.60

CONVALLARIA majalis 'Hardwick Hall'		1'	£6.40
Green leaves edged in creamy yellow, with scented flowers.			
CONVALLARIA majalis 'prolificans'		9"	£6.40
Double, white, lily-of-the-valley, fragrant and good in shade. Flowers in early summer.			
CONVALLARIA majalis var. rosea		9"	£6.40
A lily-of-the-valley with small, fragrant, pinkish flowers.			
CORYDALIS 'Craigton Blue'		1'6"	£6.80
Vigorous hybrid with intense sky-blue flowers in early summer.			
CRAMBE cordifolia		5'	£7.60
Huge dark green leaves, thick stem supports a cloud of tiny white flowers in summer.			
CRAMBE maritima	AGM	2'	£7.60
Wonderful large grey leaves, head of tiny white flowers in early summer.			
CROCOSMIA x crocosmiiflora 'Zeal Tan'		2'	£7.50
Bright orange flowers with a yellow eye.			
CROCOSMIA 'Fire King'		2'	£7.50
Dark green leaves. Deep crimson-scarlet flowers in late summer. Vigorous in well drained conditions.			
CROCOSMIA 'Okavango'		3'	£7.50
Large coppery-peach flowers in late summer. Sterile, so flowers for a long period. Needs sun. PBR			
CROCOSMIA 'Orange Pekhoe'		2'	£7.50
Interesting flowers with orange and yellow alternate petals. Backs of the flowers are red. PBR			
CROCOSMIA 'Paul's Best Yellow'	AGM	3'	£7.80
Huge golden-yellow flowers reminiscent of 'Lucifer' and just as vigorous.
