An Ernst Pagels introduction with excellent dark foliage in the spring and dark purple flowers. Deciduous.

EPIMEDIUM x perralchicum 'Frohnleiten'

Spiney evergreen leaves and large, showy, yellow flowers in spring. Will tolerate dry conditions.

EPIMEDIUM 'Pink Elf'

Delightful pale-pink flowers with a darker pinky-bronze cup. Flowering in early spring. Evergreen foliage. Good in shade. **PBR**

EPIMEDIUM x rubrum

Good foliage staying on the plant until the following spring, having coloured to red in the autumn. Rose-pink flowers in the spring.

EPIMEDIUM x versicolor 'Sulphureum'

Evergreen foliage marked with bronze in the autumn. Bronzy new foliage in the spring is excellent with the pale yellow flowers.

Another Ernst Pagels introduction. Evergreen with pale orange flowers in spring.

Dusky violet and white flowers in spring. Deciduous.			
EPIMEDIUM x youngianum 'Niveum'	AGM	1'	£6.60
Small white flowers on this easy variety.			
EPIMEDIUM x youngianum 'Roseum'		9"	£6.60
A cross between E. diphyllum and E. grandiflorum. Pink flowers in spring. Prefers some shade and not too dry.			
EQUISETUM hyemale		3'	£6.80
Decorative evergreen shoots with dark black rings up the stems. Runs, so excellent in a pot.			
ERIGERON karvinskianus 'Lavender Lady'		9"	£7.50
Makes a mound of foliage covered with lavender daisies all of the summer.			
ERIGERON karvinskianus	NEW AGM	1'	£ 5.50
Small white daisy flowers which fade to pink. Sun and then seeds around.			
ERIGERON 'Sommerabend'		16"	£7.50
Semi-double dark-violet flowers with yellow centres. Mid-summer.			
ERODIUM pelargoniflorum	NEW	1'	£7.50
Soft apple green leaves. White flowers spotted and streaked with pink in early summer. Needs well drained conditions and sun.			
ERYNGIUM agavifolium		4'	£7.80
Rosette of green leaves, strong upright stems topped by moss green thistles. Best in dry conditions.			
ERYNGIUM 'Lapis Blue'		16"	£7.60
Green and white foliage, blue thistles darken with age. Dry, well-drained conditions. Bee plant.			
ERYNGIUM x zabelii 'Big Blue'		2'	£7.60
Large thistle heads opening pale blue and darkening with age.			
ERYNGIUM x zabelii 'Jos Eij King'	NEW	2'	£7.80
Lavender-blue flower heads on a statuesque plant. Good in dry conditions in late summer. PBR			
ERYNGIUM x zabelii 'Neptune's Gold'		2'	£7.60
The plant of 2014. Bright golden foliage, in the spring fades to soft yellow when the blue thistles appear. PBR			
EUPATORIUM fistulosum f. albidum 'Massive White'	AGM	6'	£7.90
Vigorous form with strong stems and large heads of white flowers. Good for butterflies.			

EUPATORIUM maculatum ‘Atropurpureum’		6'	£7.90
Purplish stems and deep purplish-rose coloured flowers on this striking plant. Flowers in early autumn and needs space and rich soil.			
EUPATORIUM rugosum ‘Chocolate’ <i>Re-named AGERATINA altissima ‘Chocolate’</i>			
EUPHORBIA characias ‘Silver Edge’		2'	£8.00
Compact form with grey leaves edged with white. Needs good drainage and sun.			
EUPHORBIA epithmoides ‘Bonfire’		18"	£7.90
Compact with green foliage flushed maroon. Bright yellow flowers in spring. Sun. PBR			
EUPHORBIA palustris		3'	£7.90
Large flower heads of yellow in late spring. Foliage turns yellow in autumn.			
EUPHORBIA schillingii	AGM	3'	£7.90
Clump forming with dark green leaves and paler veins. Lime green flowers in late summer.			
EUPHORBIA mellifera	AGM	4'	£8.00
This has survived in our garden on a west wall. Lovely bright green leaves with a paler rib. Flowers in early summer are honey-scented.			
EUPHORBIA myrsinites	AGM	6"	£7.60
Prostrate stems, grey leaves, lime-green flowers.			
EUPHORBIA wallichii.		18"	£7.90
Upright clump of dark green foliage with white midribs. Bright yellow flowers in early summer.			
EUPHORBIA x martinii	AGM	2'	£7.90
A good cross between E. amygdaloides and E. wulferii. Evergreen. Sun			
EUPHORBIA x martini ‘Ascot Rainbow’	AGM	18"	£7.90
Excellent hardy form with pale yellow edges to the leaves and lime green flowers. Foliage becomes tinged with red in colder months.			
EUPHORBIA x pseudovirgata		2'6"	£7.20
A running euphorbia with grey-green foliage, erect stems topped with yellow flower and yellow bracts. Late Summer.			

EURYBIA divaricatus

Black stems and dark green leaves topped with tiny white flowers in autumn. Lovely flopping over plants which flower earlier.
