Ornamental berries start cream turn blinding red.

Furry grey leaves, flowers in dense spikes of mauve,

Variegated form of Apple Mint.

Ginger mint. Solid flecked foliage. Runs.

Like a small Tiarella. Round green leaves with greenish
flowers. Spreads quickly in cool moist soil.

Deep maroon buds opening to pale pink flowers on a
bushy plant. No mildew and good for bees **PBR**

MONARDA bradburiana 'Maramek'

The usual aromatic foliage topped with soft pink flowers

plant.
