ECHINACEA purpurea 'Rubinstern'

Large, ruby-red flowers in late summer, held on sturdy stems. **PBR**

ECHINACEA purpurea 'White Swan'

Large broad-petalled daisy flowers, white with a large dark central cone, all summer and into the autumn. **PBR**

ECHINOPS bannaticus 'Taplow Blue'

Grey woolly leaves and stems topped with globes of pale flowers. Bee plant.

OMECON chionantha

Large round leaves of grey-green tinged with brown. Nodding white flowers in spring. Spreading woodland plant.

EPILOBIUM angustifolium var. album

Now known as *Chamerion angustifolia alba*.

EPIMEDIUM 'Amber Queen'

Golden yellow flowers which turn orange. Spring. **PBR**

AGM 1' £6.60

EPIMEDIUM grandiflorum 'Rose Queen'

Deep pink flowers in the spring. Deciduous.

EPIMEDIUM x perralchicum 'Frohnleiten'

Spiney evergreen leaves and large, showy, yellow flowers in spring. Will tolerate dry conditions.

EPIMEDIUM 'Spine Tinger'

Small, dainty, pale yellow flowers, narrow spiny-edged foliage starts bronze and then turns green.

EPIMEDIUM x rubrum

Good foliage staying on the plant until the following spring, having coloured to red in the autumn. Rose-pink flowers in the spring.

EPIMEDIUM x versicolor 'Sulphureum'

Evergreen foliage marked with bronze in the autumn. Bronzy new foliage in the spring is excellent with the pale yellow flowers.

EPIMEDIUM x warleyense 'Orangekonigin'

Another Ernst Pagels introduction. Evergreen with pale orange flowers in spring.

EPIMEDIUM x youngianum 'Merlin'

Dusky violet and white flowers in spring. Deciduous.

EPIMEDIUM x youngianum 'Niveum'

Small white flowers on this easy variety.

EPIMEDIUM x youngianum 'Roseum'		9"	£6.60
A cross between E. diphyllum and E. grandiflorum. Pink flowers in spring. Prefers some shade and not too dry.			
EQUISETUM hyemale		3'	£6.80
Decorative evergreen shoots with dark black rings up the stems. Runs, so excellent in a pot.			
ERIGERON annuus		3'	£7.50
A cloud of small white daisies all summer. Short lived perennial, good bee plant.			
ERIGERON karvinskianus 'Lavender Lady'		9"	£7.50
Makes a mound of foliage covered with lavender daisies all of the summer.			
ERIGERON karvinskianus	AGM	1'	£ 5.50
Small white daisy flowers which fade to pink. Sun and then seeds around.			
ERYNGIUM agavifolium		4'	£7.90
Rosette of green leaves, strong upright stems topped by moss green thistles. Best in dry conditions.			
ERYNGIUM bourgatii 'Lapis Blue'	NEW	18"	
The Thistle heads open blue and becoming darker during the summer. A goo form for bees and dry places.			
ERYNGIUM bourgatii 'Picos Amethyst'		18"	£7.90
A mound of finely cut marled foliage. Blue-purple thistles. Sun and dry conditions.			
ERYNGIUM planum	NEW	18"	
Bright blue spiky flowers heads above rosettes of open rounded foliage. Good for bees and drying.			
ERYNGIUM x zabelii 'Big Blue'		2'	£7.90
Large thistle heads opening pale blue and darkening with age.			
ERYNGIUM x zabelii 'Jos Eij King'		2'	£7.90
Lavender-blue flower heads on a statuesque plant. Good in dry conditions in late summer. PBR			
ERYNGIUM x zabelii 'Neptune's Gold'		2'	£7.90
The plant of 2014. Bright golden foliage, in the spring fades to soft yellow when the blue thistles appear. PBR			
EUPATORIUM cannabinum	NEW	4'	
Red stems topped by flat heads of flowers. This is the British native, hemp agrimony, loved by bees and butterflies. Seeds about!			

EUPATORIUM fistulosum f. albidum ‘Massive White’ Vigorous form with strong stems and large heads of white flowers. Good for butterflies.	AGM	6’	£7.90
EUPATORIUM maculatum ‘Atropurpureum’ Purplish stems and deep purplish-rose coloured flowers on this striking plant. Flowers in early autumn and needs space and rich soil.		6’	£7.90

EUPHORBIA characias ‘Purple and Gold’ Foliage is green with the usual yellow flowers in spring but as the weather grows cold the foliage turns purple in winter		3’	£7.90
EUPHORBIA characias ‘Silver Edge’ Compact form with grey leaves edged with white. Needs good drainage and sun.		2’	£8.00
EUPHORBIA epithmoides ‘Bonfire’ Compact with green foliage flushed maroon. Bright yellow flowers in spring. Sun. PBR		18”	£7.90
EUPHORBIA ‘Miner’s Merlot’ Burgundy foliage, lime-green flowers. Sun PBR		18”	£7.90
EUPHORBIA palustris Large flower heads of yellow in late spring. Foliage turns yellow in autumn.		3’	£7.90
EUPHORBIA schillingii Clump forming with dark green leaves and paler veins. Lime green flowers in late summer.	AGM	3’	£7.90
EUPHORBIA mellifera This has survived in our garden on a west wall. Lovely bright green leaves with a paler rib. Flowers in early summer are honey-scented.	AGM	4’	£8.00
EUPHORBIA myrsinites Prostrate stems, grey leaves, lime-green flowers.	AGM	6”	£7.60
EUPHORBIA wallichii. Upright clump of dark green foliage with white midribs. Bright yellow flowers in early summer.		18”	£7.90
EUPHORBIA x martinii A good cross between E. amygdaloides and E. wulferii. Evergreen. Sun	AGM	2’	£7.90

EUPHORBIA x martini ‘Ascot Rainbow’ Excellent hardy form with pale yellow edges to the leaves and lime green flowers. Foliage becomes tinged with red in colder months.	AGM	18"	£7.90
EUPHORBIA x pseudovirgata A running euphorbia with grey-green foliage, erect stems topped with yellow flower and yellow bracts. Late Summer.		2'6"	£7.20
EURYBIA divaricatus Black stems and dark green leaves topped with tiny white flowers in autumn. Lovely flopping over plants which flower earlier.		2'	£7.60
EURYBIA x herveyi formerly ASTER macrophyllus ‘Twilight’ Heart-shaped leaves, violet flowers in August. Will grow in shade.		2'6"	£7.60
