LAMIUM maculatum 'Aurea'

Creeping golden foliage, pink flowers which are better removed! Semi-evergreen.

LAMIUM maculatum 'Beacon Silver'

Silver leaves with a narrow green edge, pink flowers.

LAMIUM orvala

A coppery pink dead nettle flowering in the spring. Clump forming. Much admired in the garden.

LAMPROCAPNOS spectabilis

Rosy-red flowers conjuring up names such as Bleeding Hearts. Good, bright green foliage.

LAMPROCAPNOS spectabilis 'Alba'

Wonderful white form.

LATHYRUS aureus

Clump-forming, with golden pea flowers in early summer.

LATHYRUS grandiflorus

A running perennial pea with purple-pink flowers in summer

LATHYRUS rotundifolius

Climbing perennial pea with small terracotta flowers

LATHYRUS vernus

A delightful plant flowering in May with mauve pea flowers.

LATHYRUS vernus alboroseus

Flowering in May and covered with candy-floss pink flowers.

LATHYRUS vernus 'Filifolius'

Flowering in spring with fine foliage and purple-blue flowers.

LAVATERA arborea 'Variegata'

Large soft cream variegated evergreen leaves, purple flowers, monocarpic but self-seeds.

LEPTINELLA squalida

Bronze tinted, deeply cut leaves make a flat evergreen carpet.

LEUCANTHEMELLA serotina

A wonderful plant in October, covered with large white green-eyed daisies on stiff branching stems. Large pots.

LIBERTIA formosa

Good clumps of evergreen foliage. Sprays of white flowers in early summer. Needs sun and good drainage.

LIGULARIA ‘Brit-Marie Crawford’	AGM	4’	£7.80
Similar to L. ‘Desdemona’, with the same orange flowers in late summer but darker brown leaves. An improvement. PBR			
LIGULARIA ‘Osiris Fantaisie’		18”	£7.80
Deeply serrated deep green leaves, dark maroon underneath. Golden yellow flowers. Compact. A few only			
LIGULARIA ‘The Rocket’	AGM	5’	£7.80
Almost black stems and dark green foliage ending in narrow spires of yellow flowers. Needs moisture.			
LIGUSTICUM lucidum		3’	£7.50
Feathery foliage in a neat clump. Large white cow parsley flowers. Fragrant. Monocarpic.			
LIRIOPE muscari	AGM	1’	£7.50
Excellent evergreen grassy leaves, dense spikes of violet flowers in autumn. Does well in semi-shade.			
LIRIOPE muscari ‘Monroe White’		1’	£7.50
Evergreen clump of narrow dark green leaves. Large spikes of white flowers in autumn.			
LIRIOPE muscari ‘Okina’		1’	£7.50
Ghostly white variegated foliage in spring which becomes green as summer progresses. Purple flowers in autumn. Evergreen. Good in shade.			
LOBELIA ‘Compton Pink’		2’	£7.60
Lovely pale pink flowers with a deep pink centre. Late summer. A few only			
LOBELIA x speciosa ‘Hadspen Purple’		2’9"	£7.60
Stunning deep-purple flowers on a compact upright plant. Much admired in the garden and hardy here. PBR			
LOBELIA X speciosa ‘Pink Elephant’	AGM	3’	£7.60
Strong pink flowers in late summer. Not too dry conditions.			
LUNARIA annua ‘Chedglow’		2’6”	£7.50
Dark foliage and scented purple flowers in spring. Needs sun to colour well. Biennial.			
LUNARIA annua ‘Corfu Blue’	AGM	3’	£7.50
Blueish-purple flowers in spring. Usual seed heads. Short-lived perennial.			
LUNARIA rediviva	AGM	2’	£7.50
Perennial Honesty. Lilac flowers followed by elliptical papery seed pods.			
LUPINUS ‘Polar Princess’		2’6”	£7.90
Lupin with pure white flowers in dense spikes in mid-summer			

LYCHNIS coronaria ‘Alba’		£7.50
The usual grey rosette of leaves and white flowers. Dry conditions.		
LYCHNIS coronaria Atrosanguinea Group	2’6”	£7.50
The magenta form, permanent grey foliage, single magenta flowers from mid-summer to the frosts.		
LYCHNIS coronaria ‘Gardener’s World’	2’	£8.00
Double magenta flowers, overwintering grey rosettes of foliage. Sterile, so no seeding problems. Very few available		
LYCHNIS ‘Petite Henri’	16”	£7.50
Shaggy double white flowers on compact plants		
LYCHNIS yunnanensis	18”	£7.50
Dense sprays of bright pink flowers on numerous thick stems.		
LYSIMACHIA barystachys ‘Huntingbook’	4’	£8.00
Collected when we went to Jimi Blake’s garden. Spires of small white flowers. Dark stems and grey foliage.		
LYSIMACHIA ciliata ‘Firecracker’	AGM 3’	£7.50
Dark brown leaves contrast well with the usual yellow flowers in July.		
LYSIMACHIA ephemerum	AGM 3’	£7.80
Greyish leaves, elegant spires of white flowers in a tidy clump. Summer		
LYSIMACHIA punctata	18”	£7.00
A spreading plant with upright stems and whorls of yellow flowers. Pond edges or grassland. Flowers in early summer.		
LYTHRUM salicaria ‘Blush’	AGM 2’6”	£7.60
A pale pink form of this useful August flowering plant.		
LYTHRUM salicaria ‘Feuerkerze’	AGM 3’	£7.60
Intense rosy-red flowers. Lythrums are useful in flowering in July/Aug, giving relief from the many yellows at that time.		
LYTHRUM salicaria ‘Swirl’	AGM 3’6”	£7.80
Clouds of small red-pink flowers in summer.		
LYTHRUM virgatum ‘White Swirl’	2’6”	£7.80
Graceful habit, pale mauve flowers fade to white. Originating from Piet Oudorf
