

Plants S- 2026

SALVIA forskaohlei

Large hairy basal leaves from which rise the stems carrying purplish blue flowers with a white throat. Perennial. Needs sun.

SALVIA glutinosa

A strong growing plant with large hairy leaves and yellow flowers. Good in shade.

SALVIA leucantha 'Waverley'

Pretty pale violet flowers with dark calyces. Not hardy.

SALVIA nemorosa 'Caradonna'

Erect, with dark purple stems and spikes of violet-blue in summer. Needs dry conditions and sun.

SALVIA nemerosa 'Sensation Rose'

Spikes of rosy-pink flowers in a purple calyx. Dead head for continual flowering

SALVIA sclarea var. turkestanica 'Vatican Pink'

NEW

Strongly aromatic foliage, tall branched stems of pinkish white flowers and pink bracts. Biennial

SALVIA x sylvestris 'Rose Queen'

Bushy plant with aromatic foliage and spikes of dark buds opening to rose pink. Sun.

SALVIA verticillata

Soft dark green leaves, spires of violet blue flowers into autumn

SAMBUCUS ebulus

The only herbaceous form of Elder. The flowers and berries are the same but this has running roots and disappears in winter.

SANGUISORBA canadensis

Tall white spikes in late summer. Lovely autumn colour on the foliage and flower spikes.

SANGUISORBA menziesii

Deep maroon-red bottle brushes above glaucous foliage.

SANGUISORBA obtusa

Grey pinnate foliage, large bottle brush flowers of a beautiful deep pink.

SANGUISORBA officinalis 'Pink Tanna'

Small bottle brush flowers of rose pink. Mid-summer.

SANGUISORBA 'Tanna'

A mound of foliage, stiff stems and ruby-red bobble flowers

Tall upright stems topped by nodding red flowers in late summer.			
SANGUISORBA tenuifolia var. alba		4'	£7.90
A mound of beautiful pinnate green foliage from which arise slender stems topped with long fluffy white flowers.			
SAPONARIA officinalis		2'	£7.50
Soapwort. We shall have both the single and double flowered forms of this British native.			
SCABIOSA incisa 'Kudo'		18"	£7.50
Large pink scabious flowers from spring onward. Excellent bee plant for sun.			
SCHIZOSTYLUS coccinea 'Wilfred H Bryant'	See <i>HESPERANTHA</i> .		
SCROPOLIA carniolica		16"	£7.70
This was collected by Will McLewin in Yugoslavia. The flowers are yellow inside, brownish-purple on the outside. Needs moist semi-shade and creeps by fleshy rhizomes. Flowers in April.			
SCUTELLARIA lactiflora	NEW	2'	
Upright herb with spikes of shell blue tubular flowers most of the summer.

SIDALCEA candida		3'	£7.60
Good spikes of white flowers in summer. Rather like a small Hollyhock.			
SIDALCEA 'Elsie Heugh'	AGM	3'	£7.50
These are very useful plants flowering in August and elegantly upright. This form has rose-pink coloured flowers.			
SILENE dioica 'Clifford Moor'	NEW	1'	
Pink flowered campion with green and yellow variegated foliage. A gift from the nursery where it was named. A few only.			
SILENE fimbriata		2'	£7.60
Like the common white campion but the flowers have fringed petals and are backed by large baggy calyces. Much admired in late May.			
SILENE 'Firefly'		18"	£7.50
Magenta pink double flowers in early summer, ideal for the cottage garden look. PBR			

SILENE ‘Rollie’s Favourite’ Compact form of common native campion, flowers from April onwards, very free flowering. PBR	18"	£7.50
SINACALIA tangutica Clouds of scented yellow flowers on tall blackish stems in autumn. Excellent fluffy seed heads. Not dry conditions. Can run if happy.	4'	£7.80
SINOPODOPHYLUM hexandrum Clump forming with down mottled leaves in early spring. Goblet-shaped pink flowers in spring.	3'	£7.90
SINOPODOPHYLLUM peltatum A woodlander, needing moist fertile soil. One large lobed leaf, the nodding cream flowers followed by a rosy fruit. Vigorous.	18"	£7.90
SISYRINCHIUM striatum Iris-like leaves, spires of cream flowers. Needs good drainage.	18"	£7.50
SISYRINCHIUM striatum ‘Aunt May’ Good form with cream edges to the leaves.	18"	£8.00
SMILACINA racemosa see <i>Maianthemum racemosum</i>		
SOLIDAGO flexicaulis ‘Variegata’ Broad leaves, speckled with gold. Sprays of soft yellow, fragrant flowers in summer.	3'	£7.60
SOLIDAGO ‘Loysder Crown’ Sprays of fluffy lemon-yellow flowers in late summer. Loved by bees.	3'6"	£7.60
SOLIDAGO x luteus ‘Lemore’ Tiny light-yellow daisies in loose heads. Flowers in July and August.	AGM 2'	£7.70
SOLIDAGO rugosa ‘Fireworks’ Arching stems of small yellow flowers in late summer until the frosts.	AGM 3'	£7.70
STACHYS macrantha see <i>BETONICA macrantha</i>		
STACHYS officinalis ‘Hummelo’ Pretty rose pink flower spikes above crinkly foliage from early summer until autumn.	18"	£7.50
STROBILANTHES nutans Similar to <i>S. attenuate</i> , but with large clusters of drooping trumpet- shaped white flowers in autumn. Needs sun and good drainage.	2'6"	£7.90

STROBILANTHES wallichii (Syn. <i>S. atropurpureum</i>) The leaves have a violet hue and the violet-blue flowers in September. Best in sun. Spoilt by late frost but always recovers.	4'	£7.90
STYLOPHORUM lasiocarpum A woodland plant with dandelion like leaves and yellow single flowers most of the summer. Good seed heads.	1'	£7.40
SUCCISELLA inflexa 'Frosted Pearls' A carpet of evergreen foliage, wavy stems topped in autumn by small scabious type white flowers with a hint of lavender. Excellent cottage garden plant, flowers for months.	2'	£7.50
SYMPHANDRA 'Paul Furse' <i>see Campanula 'Paul Furse'</i>		
SYMPHYOTRICUM 'Climax' <i>formerly Aster</i> Large bunches of single Spode-blue flowers.	5'	£7.50
SYMPHYOTRICHUM 'Little Carlow' <i>formerly Aster</i> Stiff stems ending in large clusters of mid-blue, small flowers. Long flowering from September to November.	AGM 4'	£7.50
SYMPHYOTRICHUM ericoides 'Cinderella' <i>formerly Aster</i> Wonderful in the garden in October, covered with tiny white flowers which fade to pink.	3'	£7.50
SYMPHYOTRICHUM ericoides 'Ringdove' <i>formerly Aster</i> Clouds of tiny, pale, rosy-mauve flowers in early autumn.	AGM 2'6"	£7.50
SYMPHYOTRICUM laevis 'Arcturus' <i>formerly Aster</i> A very strong growing Aster, with dark stems and blue flowers in October.	4'6"	£7.50
SYMPHYOTRICHUM novae-angliae 'Alma Potschke' <i>formerly Aster</i> Large rose-pink flowers in late summer. Large plants.	4'	£7.50
SYMPHYOTRICHUM novae-angliae 'Barr's Violet' <i>formerly Aster</i> Large amethyst flowers in October. A novae-angliae are not prone to mildew.	4'	£7.50
SYMPHYOTRICHUM novae-angliae 'Harrington's Pink' <i>formerly Aster</i> A soft clear pink, flowering in September. Large plants.	AGM 3'	£7.50
SYMPHYOTRICHUM novae-angliae 'Herbstschnee' <i>formerly Aster</i> Pure white flowers in early autumn. Mildew free. Large plants.	4'	£7.50
SYMPHYOTRICHUM novae-angliae 'Purple Dome' <i>formerly Aster</i> A dwarf variety of <i>S. 'Septemberrubin'</i> (qv).	2'	£7.50

SYMPHYOTRICHUM novae-angliae 'Septemberrubin' <i>formerly Aster</i> Large shaggy flowers of a bright ruby-red in October.	4'	£7.50
SYMPHYOTRICHUM novi-belgii 'Vignem' <i>formerly Aster</i> I bought this in Holland but can find no trace of the name here. Rather shaggy large flowers of a pretty pale lavender in early autumn.	3'6"	£7.50
SYMPHYOTRICHUM tradescantii <i>formerly Aster</i> Tiny white daisies cover the wiry stems in late autumn.	4'	£7.50
SYMPHYTUM caucasicum A strong growing comfrey with bright blue flowers.	2'6"	£7.50
SYMPHYTUM 'Hidcote Pink' Comfrey with pinkish flowers and evergreen foliage.	16"	£7.50
SYMPHYTUM ibericum (grandiflorum) Dark hairy leaves, orange-tipped cream bells in spring, grows in any soil, spreading. Evergreen.	1'	£7.40
SYMPHYTUM orientale White comfrey. Excellent pure white flowers in spring. Biennial or short-lived perennial. Bee plant.	2'	£7.40
SYNTHYRIS missurica var. stellate Deep green leaves form a clump. Numerous spikes of blue- bell shaped flowers in spring.	16"	£7.50
